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| 1. From the Harley Davidson Dealership, turn right (south) onto Beach St. | |
| 2. At Route 92 (Int'l. Speedway Blvd.), turn right (west). | 1.0 |
| 3. Take Route 92 to Deland, at the bypass, go straight. | 21.7 |
| 4. At Route 44 west, turn right. | 24.8 |
| 5. At Route 44B, turn left (approx. 23 miles from Deland). | 48.5 |
| 6. You are now in the center of beautiful old Mount Dora. | 51.7 |
| 7. Leaving downtown, take Route 441 south (also Route 500), to Apopka. (approx. 12 miles to city limit) | 64.1 |
| 8. At Route 435 in Apopka, turn left. | 65.1 |
| 9. At Kelly Park Dr., turn left. | 70.7 |
| 10. At Route 435 north, turn right. This is a very wonderful, full of curves new wide black top road. | 71.2 |
| 11. At Route 46, turn left. | 74.9 |
| 12. At Route 437, turn right. | 76.0 |
| 13. At Route 44, turn right. | 79.0 |
| 14. In Deland, at Route 15A, turn left. | 97.9 |
| 15. At the Route 92 bypass, turn right. | 99.8 |
| 16. At Beach St. in Daytona, turn left. | 121.7 |
| 17. At the Harley Davidson Dealership turn left, home again! | 122.7 |

Mount Dora is a wonderful restored old town with dozens of small antique and curio shops and many restaurants. It has a beautiful lake front and an operational antique railroad train that makes runs to Leesburg (12 mile) in season.

The return run through Apopka is a very fine ride through some open country and some excellent winding non-congested road ways. This should certainly be considered a day trip and bring along extra saddle bags for that special passenger who sees the Mount Dora downtown area for the first time.
